

Bristol Funders Network

The Bristol Funders Network (BFN) was established in 2019 to foster collaboration and communication among funders in the Bristol area. The network aims to enhance the impact of funding by sharing knowledge, co-ordinating efforts, and addressing common challenges faced by the VCSE sector.

Membership

The network's membership has grown significantly since its inception, starting with a few key organisations and expanding to include a diverse range of funders. Current members include BBC Children in Need, BBRC, Bristol Charities, Bristol City Council, City Funds, Denman Charitable Trust, Henry Smith Charity, John James Bristol Foundation, Lloyds Bank Foundation, National Benevolent Charity, Origin Foundation, Places for People, Power to Change Trust, Resonance, Sovereign Network Group, St Monica Trust, The Anchor Society, The National Lottery Community Fund, The Nisbet Trust, and Van Neste Foundation.

Key achievements

1. **COVID-19 response:** The network quickly adapted to the challenges posed by the pandemic, meeting online and supporting frontline charities.
2. **Collaborative approach to funding:** Successful collaborative approach to funding, including Bristol City Council's Impact Fund and Coronavirus Recovery Fund.
3. **Collective identification of focus areas:** The membership shares learning to help inform priority focus areas such as strengthening the capacity of the VCSE sector, underfunded areas, and funding equitably.
4. **Funders directory:** Creation and publication of a directory of funders to increase awareness of local funders, improving transparency and accessibility.

5. ***IVAR principles:*** Encouraging members to adopt the IVAR principles for flexible funding, promoting a more equitable and effective funding environment.

Meetings

The Bristol Funders Network meets six times a year, ensuring regular communication and collaboration among its members.

The Bristol Funders Network continues to evolve, with a strong focus on collaboration, fostering best practice, and addressing the pressing issues faced by our communities. Through our collective efforts, the network aims to create a more resilient and supportive environment for the VCSE sector in Bristol.
