

Guide for Applicants:

T G Heckels Fund 2026/27

1. About the T G Heckels Fund

The T G Heckels Fund has been set up to offer financial assistance to second and third year students on programmes of study based on Engineering, Maths or Physics, at the University of Bristol.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- Female students
- Students in Year 2 or 3 studying an undergraduate degree programme in Mathematics, Physics or Engineering at the University of Bristol
- Students who are the first in their immediate family to study Mathematics, Engineering or Physics

3. What you can apply for

You can apply for living costs or tuition fees.

4. Grant Awards

- Awards of up to £3000 will be available. The average grant in previous years has been £1500.
- Awards are subject to satisfactory end of year university results/ university references as appropriate.
- Awards are made for one year initially and may be reapplied annually for up to two years (excluding placement years), subject to satisfactory progress.
- If you leave your course during the award year, part of the funding may be reclaimed. Quartet Community Foundation retains full discretion when interpreting eligibility criteria.

5. How to apply

If you satisfy the eligibility criteria and want to apply, please complete an online application form.

We aim to let you know the outcome of your application by the end of November 2026.

6. Reporting on your grant award

If awarded a bursary grant, you will be required to submit a written Feedback Report at the end of the academic year following the award of the bursary grant.
